

THE RUSSELL ACTIVITY CENTER

Lee and Natalie Russell truly believed in helping others. Natalie was an advocate of physical education and was honored at Amarillo College for her work with students. The Russells generously donated money to the Lake Tanglewood Church. A community-wide steering committee thought that Lee and Natalie would be honored and recognized if their money was used to renovate the old court area and make it into a facility that could be used by both the church and the community.

The photo above shows what the Russell Activity Center (RAC) could look like. The church members unanimously voted to spend the Russell money to renovate the old athletic area. The new center will have a basketball area with six goals, a termis court, a volleyball court, multiple pickle ball courts, and a pavilion that will shelter people from the sun or rain. Half of the pavilion will be enclosed so that the church teenagers may have an area for their meetings and praise & worship. When the church is not using the RAC, it will be available to the public. Community members may reserve the RAC by scheduling at the LSIOT office.

Anyone who would like to donate in order to help complete the RAC can make a TAX-FREE donation to the Lake Tanglewood Church, 106 Tanglewood Drive, with a memo that it is for the RAC. Donations will be used to help install new fencing, central heat & air in the pavilion, and picnic tables/benches, as well as enhance the landscaping. Any donations are appreciated.

The church plans to have a cookout Memorial Day to celebrate the completion of the RAC. Everyone is invited.
