


# GOLF NEWS


Hello swingers and hackers.

### **FICTION**

**VICIOUS CIRCLE** (*C.J. Box*) The Cates family has always been a bad lot, and now they are coming after game warden Joe Pickett and his family. All he can do is prepare, and wait for them to make the first move.

**CAMINO ISLAND** (*John Grisham*) A gang of thieves stages a daring heist from Princeton University's Firestone Library. The loot is priceless—manuscripts by F. Scott Fitzgerald. Bruce Cable owns a popular bookstore on Camino Island, but makes his real money as a dealer in rare books, occasionally dabbling in the black market. And a young novelist, Mercer Mann, is hired to get close to Cable. Trouble in paradise.

**TESTIMONY** (*Scott Turow*) Bill ten Boom has walked out on everything he thought was important to him: his career, his wife, Kindle County, even his country. Still, when he is tapped to examine the disappearance of an entire Kosovo refugee camp during the Bosnian War—unsolved for ten years—he feels drawn to what will become the most elusive case of his career.

**EXILE ON FRONT STREET** (*George Christie*) After forty years in the Hells Angels, George Christie was ready to retire. As president of the high-profile Ventura charter of the club, he had been the yin to Sonny Barger's yang. Barger was the reckless figurehead and de facto world leader of the Hells Angels. Christie was the negotiator, the spokesman, the thinker, the guy who smoothed things out. He was the one who carried the Olympic torch and counted movie stars, artists, rock musicians, and police chief captains among his friends. But leaving the Hells Angels isn't easy, and within two weeks of retirement, he was told he was "out bad"—blackballed by his fellow Angels, prohibited from wearing the club patch.

**GOOD TO GREAT** (*Jim Collins*) Defy gravity! This blueprint for morphing good companies into great ones reveals how any organization can become great.

## **BIOGRAPHY**

**TALKING AS FAST AS I CAN** (*Lauren Graham*) The beloved star of TV's *Gilmore Girls* and *Parenthood* recounts her experiences on *Gilmore Girls*—the first and second time—and shares stories about life, love, and working in Hollywood.

**THE HOME THAT WAS OUR COUNTRY** (*Alia Malek*) At the Arab Spring's hopeful start, Alia Malek returned to Damascus to reclaim her grandmother's apartment, which had been lost to her family since Hafez al-Assad came to power in 1970. Its loss was central to her parent's decision to make their lives in America. In chronicling the people who lived in the Tahaan building, past and present, Alia portrays the Syrians—the Muslims, Christians, Jews, Armenians, and Kurds—who worked, loved, and suffered in close quarters, mirroring the political shifts in their country. Restoring her family's home as the country comes apart, she learns how to speak the coded language of oppression that exists in a dictatorship, while privately confronting her own fears about Syria's future

**THE GIRL WITH THE LOWER BACK TATTOO** (*Amy Schumer*) From award-winning comedian, writer, producer, and actress Amy Schumer comes this thoughtful, honest, and sometimes humorous collection of very personal essays. She mines her past for stories about her teenage years, her family, relationships, and sex, and shares the experiences that have shaped who she is as a woman with the courage to bare her soul.

**THEFT BY FINDING** (*David Sedaris*) For nearly four decades, David Sedaris has faithfully kept a diary in which he records his thoughts and observations on the odd and funny events he witnesses. Anyone who has attended a live Sedaris event knows that his diary readings are often among the most joyful parts of the evening. From deeply poignant to laugh-out-loud funny, these selections reveal with new intimacy a man longtime listeners only think they know.

**THEODORE BOONE: KID LAWYER** (*John Grisham*) Law is his life, even though he's only 13, but aspiring lawyer Theo finds himself in court sooner than he expected. ## ***Emergency Management***

Many of the newer residents to our community are unaware that we have one primary and three emergency exits from our village. These exits are there should we need them in an emergency such as a wildfire, major structural fire, gas leak, big bridge being closed or other incident. The 100 South Shore emergency exit is also an emergency exit for the Palisades and is used by the Palisades when their low water crossing is flooded.

Although these gates are kept locked, there are keys in the police, fire department and maintenance vehicles. The fire department frequently uses these gates when responding on mutual aid calls.

Should there be a need to use one or more emergency exits, the village and L.S.I.O.T. will utilize every means at our disposal to notify you. These include email, the PARIS text and email alert system, emergency personnel directing traffic and the weather radio. The emergency exits are depicted on the map and are:

### **Primary Exit: Main Gate**


**#1: South Shore to the loop, bear right on Cedar Lane (one lane and narrow). Cedar Lane turns into Frog Leap and exits to The Canyons at Currie Ridge subdivision.**

**#2: Follow North Shore to approximately 614 North Shore. Bear left on to the private driveway (Canyon Rim) (narrow twisting driveway). This will put you on John's Way in River Falls.**

**#3: Follow South Shore to the end (100 South Shore). This gate leads into the Palisades.**

Yes, we are still going to have **warning sirens** at the lake. Unfortunately, there is a shipping delay with some of the components. This will probably delay completion of the project until late July or August.






