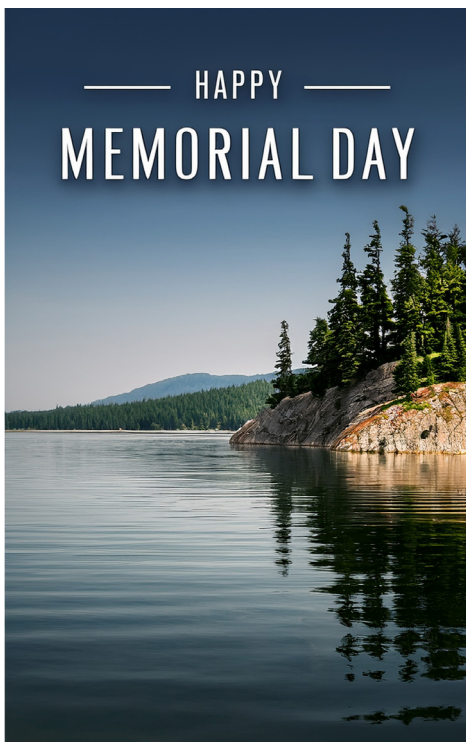

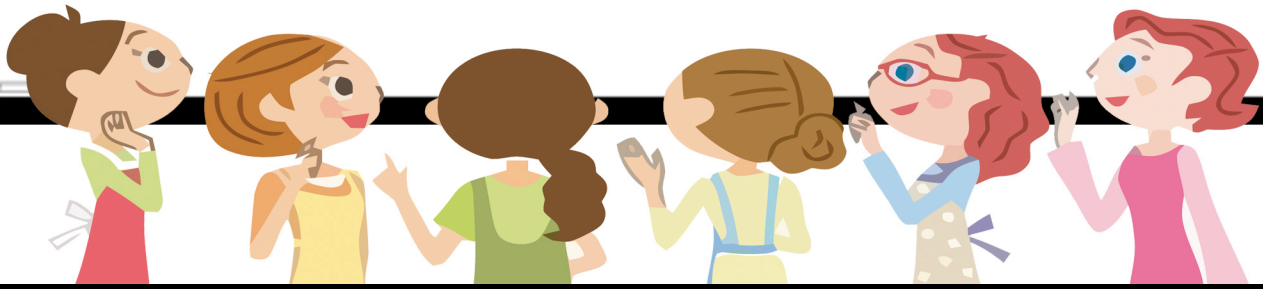

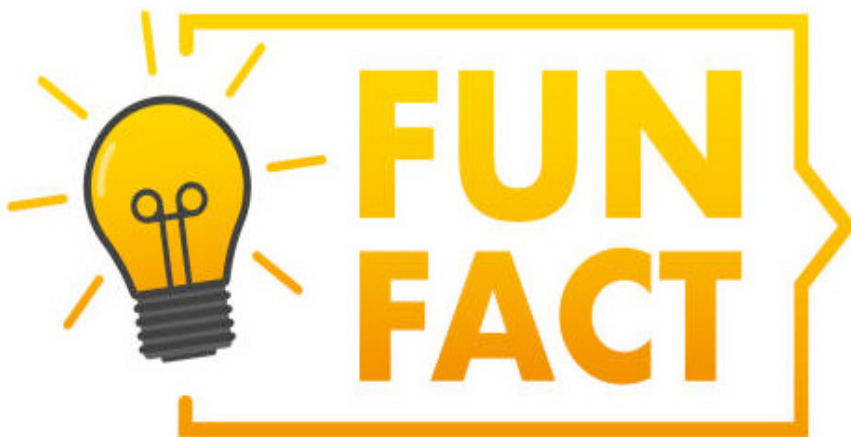

2. ALL PERMITTED WORK MUST BE APPLIED FOR, APPROVED AND PAID FOR BEFORE WORK CAN BEGIN. ALSO, THE VILLAGE MUST HAVE CURRENT LIABILITY INSURANCE ON FILE WITH THE VILLAGE OF LAKE TANGLEWOOD LISTED AS THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER.

Building Permits and Inspections

To schedule a boat dock inspection for Membership Transfer, please email the Village Office to be put on the list. Payment of \$95 must be paid prior to inspection and can be dropped off at the LSIOT or Village Offices.

All re-inspections cost \$95 and must be pre-paid to the Village of Lake Tanglewood
